Why Do You Need Offering Envelopes?

If you are a regular giver or if you have pledged you will receive offering envelopes. Anyone can have offering envelopes – you do not have to be a member. The number on the envelopes helps us to associate your giving with you and we are able to provide valuable tracking information for you. If you have a question or concern about your pledge or giving then we can look up your giving by your envelope number. We also provide year end tax statements.

Many people have commented that they don't know why they still receive offering envelopes if they give electronically or with automatic withdrawal. When we have the envelopes printed we have to get every number in the range (ex: 1-300), therefore we still pay for those envelopes so we then provide them to you as well. Some people like to have them for holidays or special giving. If you give electronically and do not wish to have the envelopes please contact Wendy Smith in the church office and she will be happy to recycle them. If you do not have envelopes and would like to receive some please contact Wendy in the church office.
