**Memorial Gardens**

Terms and Conditions for Use of the Lamb of God Memorial Gardens

1. Interment

- a. The right to interment is open primarily to members of Lamb of God Church and upon availability to non-members. Purchase of this right to reserve space in the Memorial Garden may be made at any time. The current cost is \$250 for registered members and \$350 for non-members.
- b. Ashes will be mixed into the earth in the area of the garden designated for that purpose.
- c. No other objects will be placed with the ashes.

2. Memorial Marker

- a. A Memorial Book is provided for the placement of the name and birthday and date of death for all interred in the Memorial Garden. Other interested parties may request the placement of a name and dates commemorating a loved one or ones-self by completing a request form and paying the appropriate fee. (\$250 for registered members and \$350 for non-members). The Business office of Lamb of God will make arrangement for the inscriptions of names.
- b. All other markers or other designations in the Memorial Garden, the material, design, construction, type size, shape and character thereof and all lettering, legends, or markings, shall be subject to the approval of the Pastor of Lamb of God and the Lamb of God Beautification Ministry. The use of fraternal seals, professional designations, or similar inscriptions is prohibited.

3. Services

- a. The Lamb of God Pastor shall officiate at the interment of ashes services for the deceased to be interred in the Lamb of God Memorial Garden. Any other arrangement must be pre-approved by the Pastor upon consultation with the Lamb of God Board.
- b. The Pastor or other designated person, shall place the ashes of the deceased person in the designated burial space in the Memorial Garden. The Lamb of God Business Office shall record and maintain a permanent record of the deceased.

4. Grounds
  - a. Lamb of God Church will preserve and maintain the architectural and landscape design of the Memorial Garden in order to protect the integrity of the garden and the sacred grounds there in. No flowers, plants, or other decorations shall be placed in the Memorial Garden except at the approval of the Pastor and Beautification Ministry. Artificial flowers, flags, emblems or other items placed in the garden are subject to removal and disposal.
5. Removal or Relocation of Remains
  - a. No ashes shall be removed from the garden. In the event it is necessary to change the location of the Memorial Garden or to discontinue its use or any part thereof, Lamb of God Church will have the earth area affected by such changes placed in another suitable space or location on the property of Lamb of God Church
6. Refunds
  - a. A request to rescind space agreement by Purchaser prior to death will be honored by Lamb of God Church. Requests must be submitted in writing to the Lamb of God Administrator and be accompanied by the original receipt. A refund of 75% of the original purchase only will be made to the purchaser. Twenty-five percent of the original purchase will be retained by the church to cover administration costs incurred at the time of purchase and at the time of refund. If an inscription has been placed in the memorial book, no refund will be issued.
7. Amendments.
  - a. Lamb of God Church has the right to change, modify, amend or repeal these regulations and guidelines as deemed necessary.
